



Enclosed you will find an application for Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge.

Rebuilding Together is a non-profit organization supported entirely by contributions of labor, material and money. We are dedicated to repairing homes of those who, due to financial hardship, age, and/or disability, cannot do the work themselves. Skilled and unskilled volunteers, along with able-bodied members of the recipient's family and friends, complete the repairs at no cost to the homeowner.

To be eligible for consideration, you must:

- Be at least 62 years old or have someone living in your household who currently is receiving Social Security disability;
- Own and live in your home;
- Have your home insured under a homeowner's policy; and
- Be low income per the HUD published guidelines for East Baton Rouge Parish. Income is based on the number of persons living in the household. (1-person = \$33,950, 2-person = \$38,800, 3-person = \$43,650, 4-person = \$48,500).

Volunteers provide improvements that enhance the safety and comfort of your home. Because it is primarily a short-term project, major structural repairs are not possible. Also, we need you to understand that time constraints may prevent the volunteers from accomplishing everything that you would like to have done in your home.

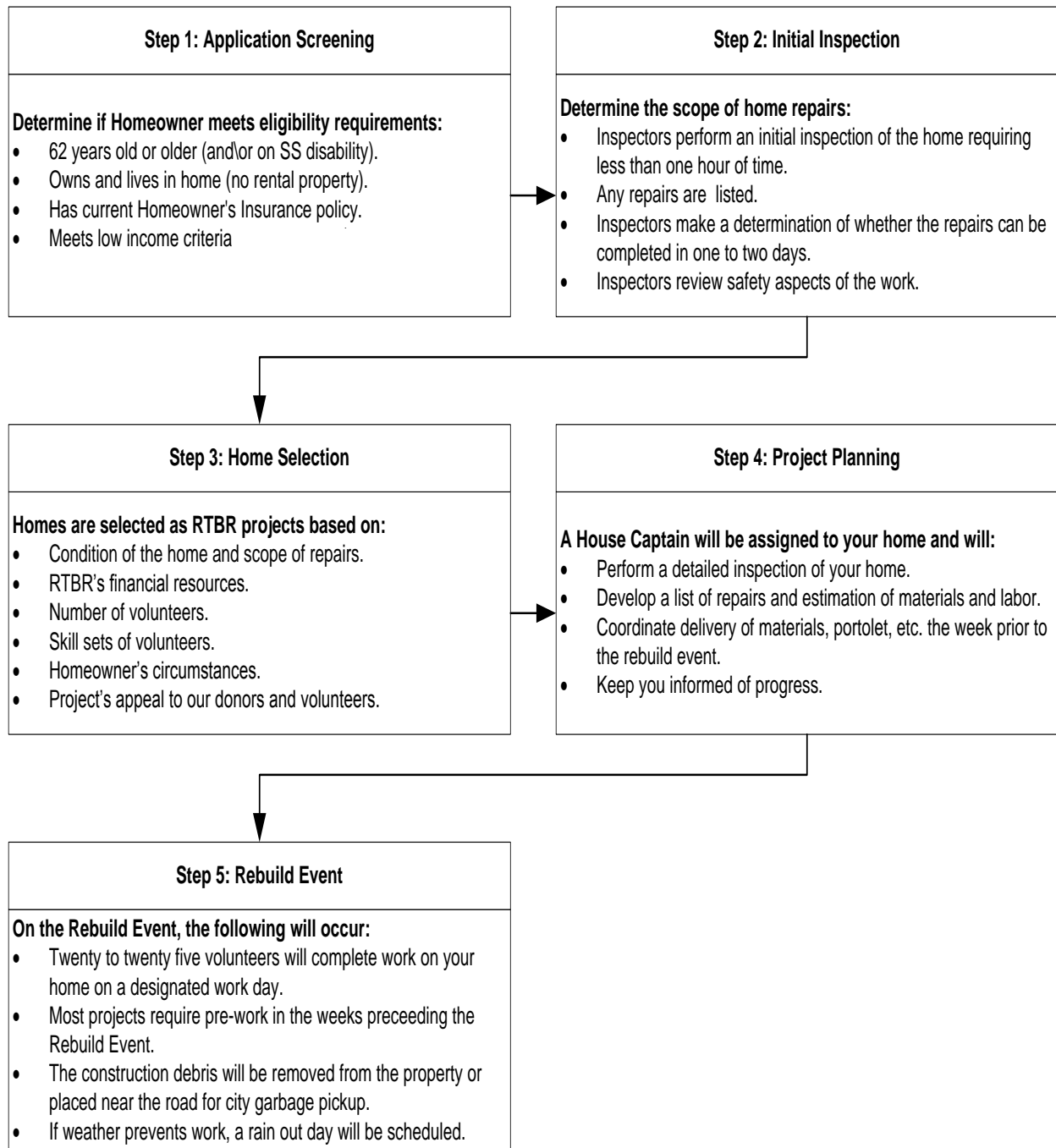
We are currently planning to complete ten to twenty rebuild projects in April of 2011 (of roughly 500 applications). To be considered for future Rebuild Events, applications must be completed in their entirety and submitted with all required supporting documentation. **Incomplete applications will not be considered. We will not contact you regarding missing information!**

Home applications are processed on a first come first serve basis and 2011 projects will be chosen by early 2011. Thank you for your interest in Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge. **Please do not call regarding the status of your application.** Rebuilding Together Baton Rouge is run by volunteers and we simply do not have the resources to answer questions from the hundreds of applicants. Please be patient with our process and the final status of your application will be communicated to you by phone or by mail.

REVIEW THIS CHECKLIST BEFORE RETURNING YOUR APPLICATION. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT CONSIDERED.

- Applicant must be at least 62 years of age or have a disabled member of household per Social Security guidelines.
- Application Form completed in its entirety.
- Proof of Income (Social Security Statement, Pension Statement, copy of last year's income tax, etc) attached to application.
- Copy of Homeowners Insurance Policy (Declaration Page) attached to application.
- Proof of Disability (If applicable) attached to application.
